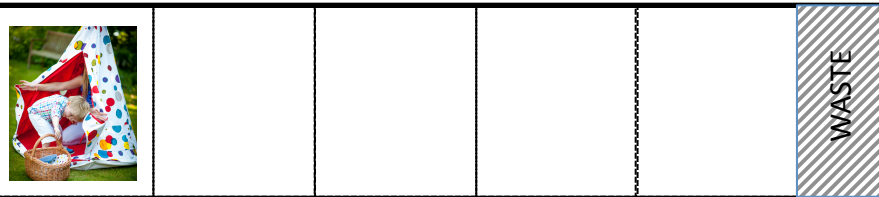


D.I.Y. CONCERTINA PHOTOBOOK

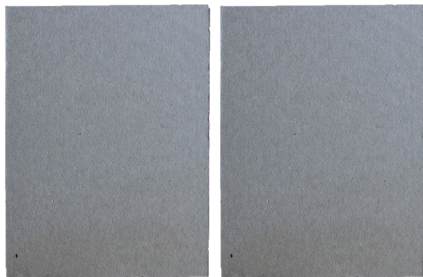

A1 Sized sheet of black craft paper

1. Place your chosen photo size on an A1 sheet of black craft paper and measure approximately 1 inch all around; this will be the size of each concertina fold.
2. Mark the same distance along the sheet, until you run out of paper. I measured 5 panels (above). You may well have a bit left over as shown above; cut this off.
3. Cut along the top line and then score along each fold before folding into a concertina shape.
4. You should get another 2 sets of concertina folds from the rest of the paper, so if you want to make more books, just repeat the steps above until you've used it up.



5. Measure and cut two pieces of cardboard, approximately 0.5 inch bigger all round than your concertina paper. Grey board is strongest for this.



6. Cover your boards with decorative paper or bookcloth. Cut the paper 1 inch bigger than the cardboard, then spray the back of the paper with glue and carefully position the board on top, snipping off the corners before folding over.



6. Lay the boards face down and then glue the back of the concertina ends; position them carefully and press down onto the boards as shown.



7. Press the book flat between heavy books whilst the glue dries, to avoid curling. Then open up and choose your photos!
